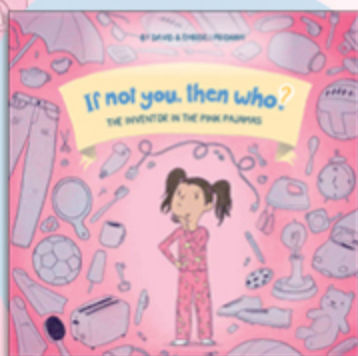

Coral Reef Creations

An activity that will encourage creative exploration! This challenge is easy to set up and your child will have a blast creating their own colorful coral reefs. Have fun with your kids while promoting **creativity and fine motor skills**.

For Ages: 3+

Time Needed: 15 min.



Challenge Objective

The objective of this challenge is to recreate coral reefs with some simple crafting materials. Jacques Cousteau invented the aqualung, a device that makes it easier to explore, collect data, and take photos while underwater.

Imagine what it's like to explore a coral reef with an aqualung and recreate it with the materials below!



What You'll Need

- Play-doh or any modeling clay for the base of the coral
- Colorful beads and pipe cleaners coiled up for the coral
- Shells, rocks, or colored pasta for decoration
- Paper and drawing utensils to create an ocean background
